STONELOW JUNIOR SCHOOL CHARGING POLICY (1988 Educ. Reform Act) & LETTINGS POLICY December 2022

1. Curriculum

Certain activities organised by School are subject to being funded by voluntary contributions or charges.

a) Charges to Parents.

A charge is made for music tuition provided at the School. This is determined by the music tutor providing the tuition.

A charge is made for the "board and lodging" element in a residential educational journey.

A charge may be made for any activity that takes place mainly or entirely outside of School hours.

For residential visits, this will be the full cost of the visit.

For after school clubs the charge ranges from £3:00 to £5:50 per session dependent on the provider.

b) Voluntary Contributions

Voluntary contributions are requested from parents for educational visits which take place wholly or mainly during school hours, and may be requested to meet the cost of visits to school from professionals such as a puppet theatre.

In the past, all events organised on this basis have taken place. This reflects the much-valued support which the School receives from parents in organising such activities for the children. However, if on any occasion there were to be insufficient contributions then the event might not be able to go ahead as planned. In this case any voluntary contributions made will be repaid.

Swimming lessons at Dronfield Pool incur a cost to the school for use of the pool, swimming teaching and coach transport. Pupils are asked to bring 50p to operate the lockers then to hand these in to the teacher as a contribution towards the transport.
