· Supervision:



Please do not support children changing or in the toilets – always call for a member of school staff and reassure the child you will do that.

· First Aid:


Children needing first aid will have this administered by Mrs Dilly, school staff including Lunch Time Supervisors who have all had appropriate training.

Physical contact:

We are a very caring school but physical contact is kept to a minimum. At times it may be appropriate to hold hands e.g. when crossing a road, but we advise you not to cuddle or hold children.
