<p>Science</p> <p>Go on an Autumn nature scavenger hunt in your backyard or a local park. Collect and identify fallen leaves, acorns, and pinecones. Create a colourful collage or poster showcasing your findings.</p>	<p>PE</p> <p>Create a sports news report based on a recent event or match of your choosing. The report could be written, performed, filmed or done as an audio file to accompany a video found online.</p>	<p>Reading</p> <p>Choose an Autumn-themed book from your library. Read it with a family member and then draw your favourite character or scene from the story.</p>
<p>English</p> <p>Write an Autumn-themed short story about a friendly scarecrow or a mischievous squirrel getting ready for the colder months. Include descriptive details about the season.</p>	<p>Maths</p> <p>Google Tangrams – make your own tangram picture. You can colour it, paint it or produce a collage. OR Create a multiplication tables game for you and your friends to play. You will need to make all the resources and devise instructions.</p>	<p>Computing</p> <p>Identify one digital device in your home and draw it showing the inputs, processes and outputs.</p>
<p>Art</p> <p>Create a beautiful autumn picture. You can paint, draw or collage.</p> <p>You can even collect autumn leaves from around Dronfield and make a leaf picture.</p>	<p>RSHE</p> <p>Discuss the importance of staying warm and healthy during Autumn. Create a simple poster with tips on dressing appropriately for the cooler weather.</p>	<p>RE</p> <p>Find out more about a religious event that is taking place this half term. For example, Diwali, Hanukkah or the meaning behind each of the weeks of advent. You can present your findings however you wish, how about trying a video 'news' report?</p>
<p>History / Geography</p> <p>Find out more about the Sahara Desert, you might want to find out about the continent it is located in, what the climate is like or plants and animals that you might find there.</p>	<p>Wellbeing</p> <p>Practice mindful leaf colouring. Collect colourful leaves and spend time colouring them with your favourite colours. It's a calming and creative Autumn activity.</p>	<p>Languages</p> <p>Design a Christmas market stall and label the items on sale in French (or another language of your choice). You might choose to sell food, toys, jewellery, gifts or even Christmas decorations. You could draw or paint your market stall, or even make a model of it. Be creative and have fun!</p>
<p>DT</p> <p>Design and craft an Autumn-themed greeting card for a friend or family member. Use craft materials like coloured paper, markers, and stickers to create a beautiful, seasonal card.</p>	<p>Music</p> <p>Create Artwork or Model Inspired by a Song. Picture yourself on stage with your favourite popstar/band, singing your beloved song. Capture the song's essence in your artwork or model. Then share your creation and explanation with the class.</p>	<p>Own Choice</p> <p>Looking at the themes across your menu, you can have a free choice of anything that you think links with any of these themes. This is particularly useful if you have a BIG idea in your mind!</p>
