



Year 6 Return to School Information Leaflet

Organisation and changes to routines

- Children need to bring a coat, named water bottle, PE kit, school bag, lunch, inhaler and glasses if needed.
- NO pencil case, stationery, toys to be brought to school.
- Children need to wear school uniform; this can be washed as usual – it does not need to be every day.
- All absence and illness must be reported by phone to the school office on 01246 414370. Children who feel ill must be off school.
- We do not encourage Y6 children to bring a phone to school, but if it is absolutely necessary, it must be switched off (not on silent) and in a bag. It is at your own risk and is your responsibility.
- Children are allowed to walk home alone if we receive parent permission for this. Please email Mrs Dilly on [info@](mailto:info@stonelow-school.co.uk) to provide this, even if you have previously given permission.

Bubbles and Classrooms

- Children are in year group bubbles. This means teaching, playtimes and lunchtimes are with those children only. If someone becomes ill within the year group bubble, this could mean the whole bubble/year group isolates together.
- Playtimes are in designated areas with each bubble having their own play equipment.
- Classrooms will be set out with tables in rows and all children are front facing in line with government guidance.
- All children will have their own set of stationery.
- Tables and high touch surfaces will be cleaned regularly.
- Each bubble has their own set of toilets and sinks for regular handwashing.

Parent and Carer Information

- When arriving at school, please be responsible for your own social distancing e.g. at drop off and pick up, maintaining distance from other parents/carers.
- Only one adult to escort children for drop off/pick up.

- Drop off and pick up need to be efficient and prompt. Teachers therefore cannot stop to speak at this time. If you need to speak with a member of staff, please call school or email and we can get back to you ASAP.

Year 6 Drop Off Organisation

- Bring Y6 children to far gate (near the park) from 8.45am. Children will walk across the playground and enter the school via the main pupil entrance, wash hands and sit down in class. The class teacher will be in classroom and a TA will greet the children to show them the way.

Year 6 Pick Up Organisation

- Collecting Y6 children at 3:20pm. Parents and carers should enter the playground through the far gate and wait on the playground in the designated area – please keep socially distanced. Staff will bring the children out to you. Please leave promptly as another class is leaving at 3.30pm from the same area.

*If you are collecting from another bubble or infant school, your child can wait with their teacher.
