# What is UNhomework?

For the second part of each term, we change homework as we know it. The phrase for the half term is 'UNhomework'.

## What will stay the same?

- 3 weekly home reads recorded in reading diaries
- Weekly spellings to practise on EdShed
- Doodle maths

# What will be different?

- Instead of weekly homework tasks for English and Maths, the children have a chance to show something they have learned by creating something to share with their class and then in the whole school gallery.
- The choice extends over all subjects and personal interests.
- There is also complete free choice on how to present what you have chosen...so actually anything goes!

# How does UNhomework work?

- Children can choose an area of learning they have enjoyed or are interested in.
- Work is shared on the date specified, and then all work can be displayed after school in our gallery at 3.00pm which children, parents and carers can attend. Please add the date to your diary.
- After the gallery, all creations are taken home.
- There is no restriction on what can be done or how/what children do.
- If children would like to do more than one, they of course can.
- Children can work independently, with a family member, or with a peer.
- This is all about creativity and fun.

# UNhomework is...

- children taking ownership of their own learning and choosing something they are interested in.
- children sharing learning with their peers, the school and families, and taking their learning in their own direction.
- meant to be a fun, free-choice activity and can be done as a project with others e.g. a family member or partner.
- completed over a number of weeks at home and brought into school for the class sharing date.



# UNhomework is not...

- a competition – there is no judging, voting, ranking.
- linked to Dojos or rewards.
- meant to be expensive – please do not spend lots of money, get creative and be resourceful (please ask if you need something from school which may have: please email the class teacher).
- supposed to be stressful or onerous.
